**Summary:** The Society for American Music, an educational organization founded in 1975 by a group of American music enthusiasts, is dedicated to promoting the study, teaching, creation, and dissemination of music in the Americas. The society was originally named in honor of American musicologist, librarian, and editor Oscar G. T. Sonneck (1873-1928), the first critical scholar and bibliographer of American music, and first chief of the music division of the Library of Congress. The records range from the founding of the society to 1999, when it changed its name to the Society for American Music. Materials include correspondence, minutes, reports, memorandums, conference materials, bylaws, handbooks, committee records, publicity and promotional materials, financial papers, materials related to its publications *American Music* and *Sonneck Society Bulletin*, photographs, and realia.

## **Processing History**

The Society for American Music Records were processed by Nancy Seeger from 2012-2013. In 2013, Seeger created the finding aid with assistance from Robin Rausch.

#### **Transfers**

Archival audiovisual materials that contain content related to the Society for American Music have been transferred to the Library of Congress Motion Picture, Broadcasting, and Recorded Sound Division, where they are identified as part of the Sonneck Society Collection (MAVIS collection no. 14886). In addition, the archive contained published print and audiovisual subventions for which the society provided funding. The books have been cataloged and transferred to the Library of Congress Music Division's general collections; and the audiovisual materials were transferred to the Library of Congress Motion Picture, Broadcasting and Recorded Sound Division. An inventory of the archival audiovisual materials and the subventions is available in the Library of Congress Music Division's collection file.

Issues of *American Music*, Sonneck Society newsletters and bulletins, and membership directories that came with the archive were bound separately, cataloged, and are shelved in the general collections of the Music Division. Bibliographic records for these publications may be found in the Library of Congress online catalog.

The Library of Congress Music Division holds the records of the Society for American Music (records pertaining to the society after it changed its name in 1999). These materials are currently unprocessed.

## **Organizational History**

The Sonneck Society for American Music was organized in 1975 by a group of American music enthusiasts led by music critic and historian Irving Lowens. Founded in response to the neglect of American music within the musicology community, in particular the American Musicological Society, the Sonneck Society promoted the study, teaching, creation, and dissemination of music in the Americas. From the beginning, the society looked beyond musicology, and attracted to its membership ethnomusicologists, music educators, folklorists, social historians, music critics, and performers.

The Sonneck Society for American Music was named in honor of American musicologist, librarian, and editor, Oscar G. T. Sonneck (1873-1928). As chief of the Library of Congress Music Division from 1902 to 1917, Sonneck built the collection into a comprehensive, world-class music research library. In 1915, he founded the journal *Musical Quarterly*, which he edited until his death. In 1917, he joined the music publishing firm of G. Schirmer in New York, and oversaw the publication of works by contemporary American composers. Sonneck was one of the first serious scholars and chroniclers of music in America.

By the late 1990s, some society members felt that the name "Sonneck" was too obscure, and lack of name recognition was hindering the growth and development of the society. After a contentious debate, on March 13, 1999, members voted to change the name from the Sonneck Society for American Music to the Society for American Music, with the stipulation that society documents would indicate it was founded in Sonneck's honor.

## **Scope and Content Note**

The Society for American Music Records span the years 1971-2001, from the earliest expressions of interest in creating such a society, through its founding and early years, to its name change to the Society for American Music in 1999. They are organized into the following series: Administrative Papers, Publications, Photographs and Realia. Most of the materials in the two biggest series, Administrative Papers and Publications, retain their original arrangement, or the arrangement later imposed by Society for American Music archivist Carolyn Bryant. In cases where the records were not in any discernible logical arrangement, they were arranged in chronological or alphabetical order.

The Administrative Papers form the bulk of the collection and are divided into the following ten subseries: Officers and Offices; Meetings: Minutes and Reports; Annual Conferences and Special Meetings; Standing Committees; Ad Hoc Committees; Appointments; Interest Groups; Brochures, Leaflets and Pamphlets; Stationery and Letterhead; and Miscellany. These papers document the day-to-day work of the society and show the breadth of its educational and research activities. There is extensive correspondence throughout most of the subseries. The Officers and Offices subseries includes the papers of six presidents, including Anne Dhu (Shapiro) McLucas, who presided over the society when the name was changed in 1999 to the Society for American Music. Notable among her files are materials that document this controversy, which provoked strong feelings on both sides of the issue. The Meetings: Minutes and Reports subseries contains agendas, minutes, and reports from the semiannual Board of Trustees meetings and annual business meetings. The organizational meetings of the early years, 1973-1975, are represented, including extensive materials relating to the November 3, 1974 meeting in Washington, D.C. where attendees voted to organize a society in Sonneck's honor. The Annual Conferences and Special Meetings subseries contains planning, programming, and registration materials for the official conferences. Notable here are documents related to the May 1973 early American music conference in Sturbridge, Massachusetts, which led to the founding of the Sonneck Society. The internal and external functions of the society are

documented in the files of the **Standing Committees** and **Ad Hoc Committees** subseries. There are very few Program Committee materials in the Standing Committees subseries as most of those files are found with the program chair files in the Annual Conferences and Special Meetings subseries. The Ad Hoc Committees oversee short term projects and specific tasks, such as revising the directory, creating a handbook, and searching for editors of the publications. The **Appointments** subseries contains files for the Archivist, Conference Manager, Committee on the Publication of American Music (COPAM) Representative (also known as MUSA Representative), RILM Representative, and Interest Group Liaison. The position of executive director, also an appointment, is represented by Kitty Van Winkle Keller's files in the Officers and Offices subseries. The **Interest Groups** subseries holds a small amount of items from various groups, such as Folk and Traditional Music, Musical Theater, Research Resources, and Students. The **Brochures, Leaflets and Pamphlets**, and **Stationery and Letterhead** subseries include a selected assortment of these items pertaining to both the Sonneck Society and *American Music*. The **Miscellany** subseries contains materials relating to Oscar Sonneck, the Sonneck Society articles of incorporation and by-laws, and papers relating to the life and death of Irving Lowens.

The **Publications** series includes files relating to both the quarterly journal *American Music* and the *Sonneck Society Bulletin* (previously named the *Sonneck Society Newsletter*). The *American Music* materials include files from its first four editors: **Allen Britton** (his *American Music* files are interfiled with his presidential files and can be found in the Administrative Papers series under his name in the Officers and Offices subseries), **John Graziano**, **Wayne Shirley**, and **Josephine Wright**. Additionally, the files from book review editors **Frank J. and Wilma Reid Cipolla**, and record review editor and discographer **Don Roberts** are present. A significant portion of the *American Music* papers relate to articles submitted for publication review, those accepted for publication as well as those rejected. There is extensive correspondence among editors, contributors, reviewers, the editorial board, the University of Illinois Press, and members of the Sonneck Society. The papers may also include abstracts, drafts, final versions, or revisions of articles and reviews, and accompanying materials. The *Sonneck Society Bulletin* materials contain working papers for each issue of the bulletin, spanning 1987-1992. There are considerable materials on book and record reviews.

The **Photographs** series mostly contains snapshots taken by attendees at conferences, but also includes a small number of miscellaneous photographs, including a 1983 formal photograph of attendees at the Keele conference and photographs of Oscar Sonneck. The **Realia** series includes tote bags, tee shirts, and buttons.

Business papers of members of the Board of Trustees, officers, committee chairs and appointees. Several of these individuals served in multiple leadership roles within the society, as well as on committees. Includes correspondence, memorandums, reports, agendas, minutes, notes, guidelines, proposals, notes, draft articles, clippings and articles, budget and financial materials, conference materials, items related to committees and interest groups, long-range planning documents, materials related to publications, publicity and press materials, election information and ballots, and drafts of the handbook.

#### BOX 1-2 Gillian Anderson, 1989-1995

Business papers chiefly relating to Anderson's presidency.

Arranged alphabetically by last name or subject.

#### BOX 3-20 Allen P. Britton, 1972-1992

Business papers relating to Britton's editorship with *American Music* and his presidency. The *American Music* materials include correspondence to and from contributors, the editorial board, and reviewers regarding submissions to the journal; items relating to the founding of the journal; editorial guidelines and style sheets; and extensive correspondence with the publisher at the University of Illinois Press. The extensive presidential papers cover a wide-range of issues regarding the activities of the society.

Papers from both positions have been combined and are arranged alphabetically by last name or subject.

#### BOX 21-22 Raoul Camus, 1975-1992

Primarily correspondence that chronicles Camus' role in the founding of the society and its activities during the first twenty years.

Arranged chronologically.

#### BOX 23-24 J. Bunker Clark, 1979-1999

Business papers that reflect Clark's various positions in the society. The "working papers" cover all of his activities and may include materials on initiatives that have been listed separately.

Arranged alphabetically by subject or type of materials and chronologically therein.

#### BOX 25-26 Dale Cockrell, 1987-1999

Business papers from Cockrell's stints as secretary and president.

The secretarial papers are arranged chronologically and the presidential papers are arranged alphabetically by subject.

#### BOX 26 Nym Cooke, 1997-2001

Emails from the Sonneck board and from the Lowens Award Committee.

#### BOX 27 <u>Dena Epstein, 1981-1990</u>

Business papers that reflect the various positions that Epstein held in the society.

#### BOX 27 Jean Geil, 1975-1985

Primarily Geil's secretarial papers which concern all activities of the society. Includes materials on the creation of the society's journal *American Music*.

#### BOX 27 H. Earle Johnson, 1974-1987

Primarily Johnson's papers when he served as vice-president. These files include a folder (placed after folder 27/11) containing a letter describing the terms of Johnson's bequest.

#### BOX 28-29 Kate Van Winkle Keller, 1975-2000

Business papers that reflect the various positions that Keller held in the society, including executive director.

Secretarial papers. The meeting materials include correspondence, preliminary and final agendas, reports, accompanying handouts and documents, handwritten raw minutes and notes, and draft and final minutes.

#### BOX 32-33 Anne Dhu McLucas, 1995-2000

Presidential papers. Contains a significant amount of materials on officially changing the name of the society from the Sonneck Society to the Society for American Music, inleuding membership ballots.

Arranged alphabetically by subject or format and chronologically therein.

#### BOX 33 Katherine K. Preston, 1997-1999

Correspondence from Preston's tenure as secretary.

#### BOX 34-35 Deane Root, 1988-1993

Presidential papers. Includes correspondence from Dec. 1991-Jan. 1992 regarding a controversy threatening the Baton Rouge conference that was reported in the *Sonneck Society Bulletin*.

Arranged alphabetically by subject or format and chronologically therein.

#### BOX 36-40 <u>Treasurer, 1975-1997</u>

Correspondence, interim, annual and projected financial reports, bank statements, deposit receipts, invoices, cancelled checks, balance sheets, stubs and transaction slips, account statements, income and expenditures, and income tax returns.

Arranged chronologically.

#### BOX 41-46 Meetings: Minutes and Reports, 1973-1999

Materials primarily from the semiannual Board of Trustees and annual business meetings. Includes preliminary and final agendas, draft and final minutes, reports, accompanying materials, budget and financial reports, handwritten notes, correspondence, and other materials relating to society business. The Board of Trustees is comprised of: president,

1st vice president, 2nd vice president, secretary, treasurer, members at large, *American Music* editor, *Sonneck Society Bulletin* editor and the executive director.

Arranged chronologically.

#### BOX 47-69 Annual Conferences and Special Meetings, 1971-1999

Planning, programming, and registration materials for the official conferences. Includes programs and schedules, presentation handouts and accompanying materials, registration materials, lists of registrants, publicity materials, flyers and brochures, Program Committee materials, local arrangements information, correspondence, planning materials, accepted and rejected proposals and papers, presentation drafts and abstracts, financial and budget items, handwritten notes, articles and clippings.

Correspondence, agendas, minutes, reports, memorandums, promotional and publicity materials, notes, announcements, policies and planning documents.

Correspondence, petitions, and reports.

#### Brochures, Leaflets and Pamphlets, 1976-1985, 1999

Sonneck Society membership brochures and renewal forms, application forms, order forms, envelopes, and promotional mailings; also includes *American Music* subscription brochures and information pamphlets, and University of Illinois Press brochures and catalogs.

#### BOX 82 Stationery and Letterhead, 1975-1996

Sonneck Society and *American Music* letterhead, envelopes, note paper.

#### BOX 83 <u>Miscellany</u>, 1975-1999

Includes articles of incorporation, by-laws and tax documents, and materials relating to the life and death of Irving Lowens.

#### **BOX 84-112 Publications, 1977-1999**

Correspondence among editors, reviewers, contributors, society officers, the editorial board, and the University of Illinois Press; abstracts, drafts and final versions of articles and reviews; press and publicity materials; lists, logs, schedules and handwritten notes; photographs and illustrations; style sheets, editorial guidelines and sample letters; clippings; budget materials; and reports.
